Shirley's Kitchen Cabinet seeks a dynamic leader with a passion for advocacy, activism and driving change in Kansas City's Black community. This internship will provide support to our change catalyst and outreach director and/or our founder. This internship will provide an excellent opportunity to gain experience in advocacy-related work while having a direct impact on our community. The ideal candidate is a self-starter, must be flexible, is solution oriented, and is willing to provide support on both substantive and administrative tasks.

This internship includes a small stipend and can count towards college credit if the college/university approves. Start and end dates can be negotiated. The candidate must own a laptop, as this is a remote/virtual internship.

RESPONSIBILITIES & QUALIFICATIONS

With the guidance of organization leadership, responsibilities during the internship will include, but will not be limited to, the following:

- Develop a funnel for recruiting, onboarding, and retaining members
- Assist in the membership program launch
- Build positive working relationships with Shirley's Kitchen Cabinet supporters
- Maintain membership database and identify areas, organizations, and segments of the community to recruit members
- Establish a partner organization database
- Make presentations and represent Shirley's Kitchen Cabinet at relevant events, community forums, and collaborative community-based projects.
- Assist with the development of strategic outreach plans and approaches; implement innovative ways to provide information and recruit supporters for leadership development, events and other initiatives.
- Assist with and lead grassroots organizing events, programs, and campaigns
- Perform all other duties as assigned in a timely manner



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QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE IDEAL CANDIDATE:

- A strong dedication to amplifying the voices of Black women
- Deep commitment to Black-centric antiracism advocacy efforts
- An understanding and appreciation of the urgent nature and time demands of campaigns
- Must have flexible work schedule and available to work non-traditional (8 - 5 pm) hours
- An effective communicator in written and oral forms
- Critical thinker i.e. ability to think objectively being present in work from multiple perspective
- Detail-oriented, proactive, ability to prioritize, and meet deadlines
- Exceedingly well organized, proactive, flexible, and dedicated to helping in a support role
- Technical computer skills, especially in Google Suite, including Google Docs and Google Sheets
- Comfortable working alone on assignments and in collaboration with others
- Experience and proficiency with social media platforms are a plus
- Previous related experience(e) in community organizing is a plus
